Scholarship Opportunities & Instructions

Please read carefully & ensure all instructions are followed Application Deadline: Friday, November 15th, 2020 at 5:00pm

4-H PEI Scholarships have been established to provide support for 4-H members aspiring to further their education. 4-H PEI is pleased to offer several scholarships in 2021, recognizing both Grade 12 graduates AND students currently enrolled in/returning to a recognized, post-secondary school of learning.

Applicant Eligibility

- ✓ Applicant must be completing Grade 12 from a recognized Island school of learning OR completing their final year of Home Education in the year the scholarship is awarded OR currently be enrolled in/returning to a recognized post-secondary school of learning.
- ✓ Applicants entering a post-secondary school of learning upon successful completion of Grade 11 are also eligible to apply for 4-H Scholarships.
- ✓ Applicant must have completed <u>at least two years</u> in the 4-H PEI Program.
- ✓ All applicants must be continuing with formal education at a recognized post-secondary school of learning beginning in September 2021

Stipulations

- ✓ Although 4-H members can apply for more than one scholarship opportunity, applicants can only be awarded with ONE provincially administered 4-H Scholarship per year.
- ✓ A 4-H member will not be awarded the same scholarship twice

Money Awarded

- Scholarships will be given in two installments. The first (\$500) will be sent in September when proof of registration (at post-secondary) has been received by the office. The second installment (\$500) will not be sent until the Provincial Office receives notice that the sponsor of the scholarship has received a formal thank you.
- If proof of registration and the thank you are received concurrently, than a cheque can be issued for full scholarship amount in September (or whenever the member chooses to submit).
- ✓ In the event that the recipient should choose to discontinue his/her studies at any time during the year, he/she is then required to notify the 4-H PEI Office and refund the remaining portion of the scholarship that has not been utilized.

<u>In-Person Interviews</u>

- ✓ One panel of judges will be recruited to review applications packages and conduct in-person interviews.
- ✓ Not all applicants will receive an in person interview. Only a select number of applicants will be chosen by the panel of judges for an in-person interview.
- ✓ Selection criteria for in-person interviews will be based on: Information included on Application, 4-H resume, short answer question/s and reference letter.
- ✓ For each available scholarship, five (5) 4-H members will be chosen by a panel of judges for an in-person interview. For the 2020-2021 year, this means:
 - o Five 4-H members will be selected for an in-person interview for the 4-H Council Scholarship
 - o Five 4-H members will be selected for an in-person interview for the 4-H Alumni Scholarship
 - For the duration of the PEI 4-H Trust Cavendish Agri Services Scholarship a maximum of ten 4-H
 members for both entry level and post secondary (twenty in total) will be selected for an in-person
 interview.

Instructions

- ✓ Only one application form is required. Please use a pen with blue or black ink to fill out application (for photocopying purposes).
- ✓ Judges will be looking for proper grammar & overall neatness throughout the entire package
- ✓ Do not assume that information is known about you use detail.
- ✓ Please do not staple any of the documents included in your application package
- ✓ The 4-H member is responsible for keeping a copy of his/her application form for reference and to assist with interview preparation.
- ✓ The member's topic of choice should be well thought out and will require preparation time. Members will be expected to speak on their chosen topic for a minimum of 5-7 minutes. One cue card, single-sided, is permitted with notes to assist the interviewee with their deliverance.

- ✓ Each applicant is expected to have a reference letter completed and submitted by a person of their choice. This person should not be a family member, relative or friend. The reference letter must be returned to the 4-H Specialist by the reference person via email or in a sealed and signed envelope. The 4-H member cannot submit the reference form to the Provincial Office on the individuals' behalf.
- ✓ Accommodations can be offered to members who may require assistance with the quiz or topic of choice due to a learning disability, or another medical reason, please let 4-H staff know in advance.
- ✓ Interviews will be scheduled for Saturday, January 2nd, 2021 applicants will be notified of interview time. If applicant is unable to attend interview in person they will be expected to call in using Facetime, Skype, Zoom or another video option of the member's choosing. This must be arranged prior to interview day.

 - ✓ Neatly filled in by hand or electronically
- ☐ 4-H Resume
 - ✓ Outline of 4-H experiences, significant 4-H awards that have been received, school and community involvement and work experience.
 - ✓ Resume must be typed, size 11 or 12 font
 - ✓ A sample of what the judges will be looking for can be found online.
- ☐ Short answer questions
 - ✓ 4-H member can choose to answer one question in 300 words or two questions in 150 words each.
 - ✓ Short answers must be typed, size 11 or 12 font, double spaced
 - ✓ Any sources used within the answer must be properly sited within the text, along with a bibliography
- Reference letter this is part of the application but should be sent directly from the individual who is writing the letter

In-Person Interview

Applicants who are chosen by the panel of judges for an in-person interview will be asked to answer general
questions, along with questions related to Past & Present 4-H Experience(s).

- Applicant will be expected to prepare to speak for 5-7 minutes about their topic of choice as outlined on the application form. Applicant will be allowed to bring one single-sided cue card to assist them with this portion of the interview.
- \square Interviews will take place on January 4th, 2021 at the Royalty Centre.
